


# Amazon Preliminary Assessment

## HirePro Preliminary English Test (PET)

HirePro Preliminary English Test (PET) is designed to measure a person's ability to understand and use English in the workplace.

This is a timed **20-minute test**, where you will need to answer **20 questions**. All questions will be in **Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) format**, where you will be given multiple answer options for each question and you will need to select the single correct option.



The test includes four sections, which will present four different types of questions as follows:

#### Fill in the Blanks:

- This section consists of items with single sentences with one missing word.
- You must read and understand the sentence, and then choose the appropriate word from the given options to meaningfully complete the sentence.
- Words may be missing in any part of the sentence, and the missing words can be from any part of speech.
- For each question, you will get Multi Choices as options. You will need to select the correct option.

#### **Error Detection:**

- This section consists of items with a single sentence with various parts of the sentence underlined.
- You need to identify which underlined part of the sentence is incorrect in the context of the sentence.
- For each question, you will get Multi Choices as options. You will need to select the correct option.

### **Sentence Correction:**

- This section consists of items with a single sentence, with a part of the sentence underlined.
- You have to identify if the underlined part in the sentence is incorrect, and if yes, choose the option which makes the sentence grammatically correct.
- One of the options will be the same as the underlined part, which you can choose if there is no error.
- For each question, you will get Multi Choices as options. You will need to select the correct option.

### **Sentence Arrangement:**

- In this section, you have to rearrange one or more sentences to form a coherent sentence or paragraph.
- In the first variant, a single sentence is broken up into different parts and you have to arrange the different parts to make a meaningful sentence.
- In the second variant, multiple sentences are given which you have to rearrange to form a coherent paragraph.
- For each question, you will get Multi Choices as options. You will need to select the correct option.
